### Low-E and LoE<sup>3</sup>-366 insulating glass

Our standard high-performance Low-E insulating glass lowers energy costs, helps homes stay cooler in the summer and warmer in the winter, prevents fading of interior furnishings, and reduces condensation. It also delivers greater visible light transmittance than tinted glass. We also offer optional LoE<sup>3</sup>-366, which offers more protection against heat gain, as well as greater energy savings.

Windows with Low-E and LoE<sup>3</sup>-366 insulating glass are also ENERGY STAR® qualified, which means they exceed the minimum energy efficiency criteria for the climate region you live in (by as much as 40 percent).

### Additional glass options

Our optional glass types include energy efficient, self-cleaning Neat™ glass; tempered glass for added safety; high-altitude glass, which prevents bowing in higher elevations; tinted glass for areas with lots of direct sun; and textured glass, which lets in light while maintaining privacy.



In warm weather, Low-E glass reflects the sun's energy and prevents it from entering the home.



In cold weather, Low-E glass reduces the amount of heat lost by reflecting it back inside.



### Clad colors

Our wood windows with aluminum clad exteriors feature a baked-on finish that does not need to be repainted over time and requires minimal maintenance. Our cladding also allows you to accentuate your home's visual appeal, because we provide a range of beautiful colors, including our two newest options—Arctic Silver and Dark Chocolate.\*

### Sizes

### Divided lites
